

GA4 Terminology

- **Users** Unique visitors to the site. The same user may visit many times. Google may even detect the same visitor using different browsers or devices.
- **Sessions** One or more pages visited and actions taken by a visitor. A user may have multiple sessions over time.
- **Pages** Each page viewed during a session. A visitor may visit the same page multiple times in the same session, e.g. if they go to the homepage many times.
- **Dimensions** an aspect of data collected used for categorization, e.g. what browsers are being used
- **Metrics** a specific count for a dimension, e.g. how many visits by Chrome browser versus Edge browser

Looker Studio Terminology

- **Chart** a single widget on a page of a report, e.g. a table, a graph, or a pie chart
- Page a collection of widgets displayed within a single screen of a report
- **Report** a set of information contained under a single "name" which can be one or more pages
